

Installation

- Unzip and upload files of the htdocs to your webserver into the directory you like to have zStore installed to.

 not the htdocs folder but the content 

- Take a look to your `z-conf.php` and add/modify at least the following information

```
$_config->adminMail = "you@domain.tld"; //database error messages will go here
$_config->contactMail = "info@domain.tld"; //not in use now
$_config->projectName = "zStore"; //for internal purposes messages

//owner/operator data (mainly used for footer info)
$_config->shopOwner = "ACME Ltd.";
$_config->shopOwnerWebsite = "https://yourOwnWebsite.com/"; //not necessarily the shop address

//admin credentials
$_config->adminUser = "admin";
$_config->adminPass = "pass";

//DB DATA
$_config->dbName = "databaseName";
$_config->dbUser = "databaseUserName";
$_config->dbPass = 'databaseUserPassword';
$_config->dbHost = "localhost"; //mysql server

$_config->tablePrefix = "z5_1_"; //prefix for the tables, can be empty too
```

- Point your browser to your installation and follow the instructions and hints.
- go to the admin page (initially `z-admin.php`) to define other settings

 Don't forget the `.htaccess` file too (it's in the htdocs folder, believe me 😊).

If you don't see it, it's maybe hidden by your file browser.

Mac OS

go to Finder

select View > enable Show System Files

Windows

open File Explorer

select View > Options >

on View tab > in Advanced Settings >

enable Show hidden files, folders, and drives

Linux

using the example of GNU Files

select Edit > Preferences > on View Tab >

enable Show hidden and backup files
